A new Maternal Health Clinic is now open at 58th and Peoria. This clinic will serve women who are without access to healthcare in this underserved community. The area has a reputation for being a hot spot of criminal activity. Last January, four women were found dead in a nearby apartment complex.

Women's healthcare needs are unique – from welcoming a new baby to preventing and fighting disease with the latest technology and treatments – and

Family Medical Care is combining education and prevention resources at the new clinic. Care will be provided for all women regardless of ethnic origin, religion or social/economic status. All deliveries and hospital care will be performed at St John Medical Center.
