Pursuant to 11 O.S. §51-108 and the 1989 Amended City Charter, I request a special election be held within the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the purpose of submitting to the registered voters, the last best offer of the City of Tulsa and the last best offer of the Lodge #93, Fraternal Order of Police, in the form as specified and required by law.


By requesting the special election, I acknowledge the City is not in the financial position to support a permanent wage increase. Because of the relatively flat sales tax collections and budget reductions we have already had to make in Fiscal Year 2013-2014 and additional reductions in programs and personnel in order to balance the FY 2014-2015 proposed budget, invoking this process is in the best interest and welfare of the City-wide departmental operations and obligations, and especially in the best interest and welfare of our taxpayers.

To ensure compliance with law, I respectfully request the City Council set on its regularly scheduled 6:00 pm, June 5, 2014, Agenda the passage of a resolution calling for the special election.

Pursuant to 11 O.S. §51-108, you are to notify the Mayor and City Council of the filing of this request for a special election. Within ten (10) days of the notification, the Mayor and City Council shall call the special election.
