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STANDARD MEETINGS

Between March 25th, 2010, and August 10th, 2010, the City Council continued to hold regular committee and business meetings on issues outside the scope of the investigation. In general terms, these meetings included:

SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Budget

One of the City Council's largest accomplishments was the passage of the FY2011 budget amid significant financial constraints and the need to prioritize services. As mentioned earlier, the City Council met 23 times over the course of three months, reviewing the budget proposals and needs of all City departments; authorities, boards, and commissions; and revising the ultimate document to reflect City Council priorities as identified in the 2010 Quality of Life Report. Council-Directed Budget Amendments

In addition to meeting their financial oversight responsibilities, several members of the City Council also researched and make changes to Mayor Bartlett's FY2011 proposed budget.

- Councilor Bynum placed a priority on getting the Tulsa Police Department's helicopters back in the air, transferring \$221,000 from Departmental travel budgets and the Mayor's Department. He also proposed transferring \$50,000 from the Tulsa Police Department to the Working In Neighborhoods Department to manage special events applications.
- Councilor Trail used an anticipated \$757,000 in unspent funds from FY2010 and reduced several General Fund accounts to purchase salt and sand for winter storms; restore highway lighting; street and pothole repair; firefighter wages; and eliminate half of the furlough days taken by City employees.
- [The City Council transferred \\$280,000 to create five new City positions](#), including: two Human Rights Department compliance monitors to ensure the ongoing disparity study is implemented; a retail development specialist and associated studies; and two parking meter readers.

Community Development Block Grant Allocations

As the legislative body for the City of Tulsa, the City Council annually determines the City’s Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) allocations for various Tulsa organizations. In 2010, the City Council [allocated \\$3,980,311 among 26 grant recipients](#) and met 8 times with representatives of the Grants Administration Department and CDBG applicants to determine appropriate funding levels for each organization.

Election Reform Task Force

The City Council's Election Reform Task Force held many of its meetings during this five-month period, and discussed potential changes to Tulsa's municipal election process. In the course of their discussions, the Task Force evaluated the processes of comparative cities nationwide, and spoke with Republican and Democratic Party representatives; members of the Tulsa County Election Board; past independent candidates; and citizen organizations.

The Task Force [ultimately proposed three recommendations](#) to the full City Council:

- Independent candidates should be treated equitably with candidates of recognized political parties. Therefore, the City should:
 - Combine the Charter provisions describing the requirements to file for office as a partisan (Art. VI, Section 3.1) or independent (Art. VI, Section 3.2) candidate so that:
 - Any candidate (partisan or independent) may file for municipal office by paying the set filing fee OR collecting the required number of signatures.
- The City should adopt the State of Oklahoma's practices for run-off elections, requiring a majority of votes for a primary election victory.
- The City should provide for primary elections for independent candidates, in addition to those held for partisan candidates.

Traffic Signal Synchronization Task Force

The City Council [created the Traffic Signal Synchronization Task Force](#) at the request of Councilor Christiansen to examine the potential benefits of implementing a city-wide traffic signal synchronization plan. Synchronizing traffic signals has been proven to increase vehicle efficiency, reduce traffic collisions, reduce pavement wear and tear, and can produce cost-benefit ratios as high as 40:1.

Disparity Study Task Force

At the instigation of Councilor Eagleton, the City Council [created the Disparity Study Task Force](#) to review and make recommendations on implementing the Disparity Study's findings. The Task Force will evaluate the best practices for implementing solutions to problems identified in the Disparity Study, and provide guidance to the two newly-created positions within the Human Rights Department.

Creation of the Economic Stabilization Reserve Fund

Initiated by Councilor Bynum after several months of work with City of Tulsa Finance Department staff, the City Council [passed a proposed Charter amendment creating an Economic Stabilization Reserve Fund](#). The Reserve Fund is designed to prevent many of the General Fund revenue fluctuations seen in the past, due largely to the City's reliance upon sales tax for a majority of its revenue. The Economic Stabilization Reserve Fund creates, in essence, a savings account for the City that is grown in good times, and drawn from in bad times.

The Charter amendment creating the Economic Stabilization Reserve Fund will be on the November 2nd ballot for voters to consider.

ShopTulsa Initiative

At the instigation of Councilor Christiansen, the Council and members of the City of Tulsa's IT Department [developed and launched the ShopTulsa initiative](#). The ShopTulsa initiative is a PR move intended to boost awareness of the City's revenue stream – most importantly its reliance on sales tax – and the direct correlation between shopping locally and the services provided by the City of Tulsa.

The ShopTulsa team acquired donations from local companies for advertisement and print purposes, and is currently developing a Citizens Task Force to carry the initiative forward. The ShopTulsa website can be found [here](#).

Ethics Advisory Committee Review

At Councilor Turner's request, the City Council [appointed a committee to review ordinances creating the Ethics Advisory Committee](#), and to make final recommendations to the Council.

Passage of PLANiTULSA Comprehensive Plan Update

The City Council held two public hearings and ultimately [passed PLANiTULSA](#), the first overhaul of the City of Tulsa's comprehensive plan in over 30 years. The passage of PLANiTULSA represented over three years of work by City staff, John Fregonese consultants, the PLANiTULSA Citizen's Task Force, the Tulsa Metropolitan Area Planning Commission (TMAPC), and hundreds of Tulsa citizens.

Sale of Old City Hall

One of the larger economic development projects overseen by the Council was the sale of the Old City Hall for retail and lodging repurposing. The Council [voted to convey the Old City Hall property to the Tulsa Development Authority](#) for private sale and redevelopment.

The Tulsa Development Authority recently voted to engage in negotiations with Brickhugger, LLC, for a proposed redevelopment as a retail and hotel space, and has asked the City Council at their August 19th business meeting to extend contract negotiations an additional 90 days.
