

TULSA CITY GOVERNMENT

AN OVERVIEW

In February, 1989, Tulsa voters approved the most sweeping changes in city government in more than 80 years. A Mayor-Council form was chosen to replace an outdated City Commission. Tulsa's elected officials are nine City Councilors, the Mayor, and the City Auditor. Tulsa's Mayor leads the administrative branch of government, managing the day-to-day operations of the City of Tulsa. The City Auditor regularly reviews the City's financial activities for efficiency, effectiveness, and legality. Findings of any investigations are reported to the Mayor and the City Council.

The legislative functions of Tulsa City Government are performed by the City Council. It approves the City's annual budget, passes local ordinances, sets City policy, listens to concerns and suggestions from citizens, and evaluates the overall effectiveness of City operations.

The City Council meets at 6:00 p.m. each Thursday, except for holidays, in the City Council Meeting Room located on the second floor of the One Technology Center in downtown Tulsa. The public is invited and encouraged to attend the Thursday regular meetings.

All City Councilors have offices on the 4th floor of the One Technology Center, and they are assisted in their duties by Council Staff and by various citizens' committees. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. City Councilors can also be reached by e-mail through the City Council website, www.tulsacouncil.org.




